

## Check preferential origin documents

CS verifies that the certificate was drawn up in accordance with the legal regulations, whereby it checks for the presence of the green guilloche background and on how certain fields of the certificate are filled in. Furthermore, said department verifies whether the certificate was issued by the correct agency and was stamped correctly.

Occasionally the terminal can have a certificate of origin EUR.1 validated by the Customs. This involves certificates EUR.1 for goods of EU origin that are intended for shipment to third countries. The certificate EUR.1 is issued on the basis of supplier statements, which are issued by our principals. All documents related to the certificate EUR.1 to be issued are saved by in a separate dossier.

Very occasionally terminal provides a certificate of origin EUR.1 via the Chamber of Commerce. This concerns certificates EUR.1 for goods of EU origin destined to be sent to third countries. The EUR.1 certificate is issued on the basis of suppliers' declarations. These supplier statements are provided by the customers. All documents relating to the EUR.1 certificate to be issued will be kept by terminal in Diva with the order number.

A separate screen is present in each order in Tomcat where information related to these preferential certificates can be saved. The entered data shall be included during the generation of the GPA. A copy of the original certificate will be stored in Diva underneath the appropriate order number and the original certificate will be stored in a folder.
